

## How to sign up

1. Go to  
[www.hoopladigital.com](http://www.hoopladigital.com)
2. Click on Log In
3. Click Sign Up Now under the heading New to Hoopla.
4. Click Choose a Library
5. Type in Barrington Public Library and click Continue
6. Fill out all boxes in Account Information and click Sign up. Note: your PIN is your library card number.
7. You are now free to browse and check out 4 titles per month, per library card.

## What's all the Hoopla About?

A new digital service that allows the downloading and streaming of music, movies, comic books, TV shows, documentaries, e-books, and audio books! This service will be available to library card holders in good standing (no overdue fees or items). Hoopla will be used in addition to our current digital service (Overdrive). This streaming\* service can be used on mobile devices or computers to watch movies, listen to music, read comics and more.

\*Streaming while connected to a Wi-Fi will not use your data minutes.

Each patron will be allowed up to 4 check outs per month as long as the monthly budget for the library hasn't been reached.
