How to Sign Up:

- Download the app or go to LibbyApp.com
- Follow the prompts to add your library (Barrington Public Library NH)
- Use your card number found on the back of your library card
- Loan up to 3 items at any one time

- Unlimited borrows
- Use the 'available now' button to sort for items that have no wait!
- Reserve up to 5 loans in the app and be alerted when they're ready

- Follow the prompts to create your account
- Select your library (Barrington Public Library NH) from the drop down
- Use your card number found on the back of your library card for both the library card number and your pin
- Loan up to 3 items a month
